- 1. Rules:** the regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017 – 2020*, this *Notice of Race*, and the *Sailing Instructions* for the Gold Country Yacht Club's 36th Annual Gold Country Regatta (aka "Go For The Gold" Regatta).
- 2. Advertising:** advertising will be restricted to Category A.
- 3. Classes:** 4 or more boats of the same type may constitute a class with boat-for-boat scoring. Open classes for multi-hull and centerboard boats will use Portsmouth Yardstick handicaps. Open keel boats will use PHRF SoCal handicaps.
- 4. Eligibility:** participation in this regatta is limited to the first 100 boats entered.
- 5. Registration & Fees:** the racing registration form and associated fees will be available on the Gold Country Yacht Club web site at www.gcyc.net no later than April 1, 2018. Early registration will close on May 26, 2018. A late fee of \$10 will be assessed after that date. Registration will close on the morning of June 2, 2018 at 0900 hours. A discount for US Sailing members will be offered with proof of US Sailing membership. Receipt of registration will be determined by the postmark on the envelope or when received by the Registrar of the Organizing Authority if hand delivered.
- 6. Schedule of events:**
 - Friday June 1, 2018 1500 – 1700 On-site Late Registration
 - Saturday June 2, 2018 0800 – 0900 On-site Late Registration
 - Saturday June 2, 2018 1100 Race 1, 2, 3, plus more determined by RC
 - Sunday June 3, 2018 1100 Race 4, 5, plus more determined by RC
- 7. Measurements:** each boat racing in a class must comply with all class requirements. The Organizing Authority may perform a boat inspection at any time during the regatta.

8. **Sailing Instructions:** the *Sailing Instructions* will be accessible no later than May 1, 2018 on the Gold Country Yacht Club web site at www.gcyc.net and provided in the skipper's packet at the Gold Country Yacht Club regatta registration desk at Scotts Flat Lake.
9. **Course:** the courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward or triangular with up to eight legs as described in the *Sailing Instructions* and as determined by the Race Committee.
10. **Racing Area:** the racing area will be on Scotts Flat Lake, except in areas designated as swimming and mooring areas as described in the *Sailing Instructions*.
11. **Scoring:** the Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A of *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017 - 2020* will apply. One throw-out is taken if five (5) races are sailed, with a minimum of three (3) races constituting a regatta. The Race Committee will try to run as many races as possible. The racing results will be posted on the Gold Country Yacht Club website at www.gcyc.net.
12. **Trophies and Awards:** The number of awards will be determined by the number of boats participating in each class.
13. **Amendments to the Notice of Race:** The Organizing Authority reserves the right to amend this *Notice of Race* from time to time. Please check www.gcyc.net for updates.xi
14. **Additional Information:** Admittance to Scotts Flat Lake is under the control of the State of California, Department of Boating and Waterways. A fee to enter and launch your boat at Scotts Flat Lake will be collected by Nevada Irrigation District at Gate #2 upon entry. Camping, laundry, fishing boat rentals and a General Store are available at Scotts Flat Lake. Local camping, lodging, local attractions, and restaurant information will be available on the Gold Country Yacht Club website at www.gcyc.net.
